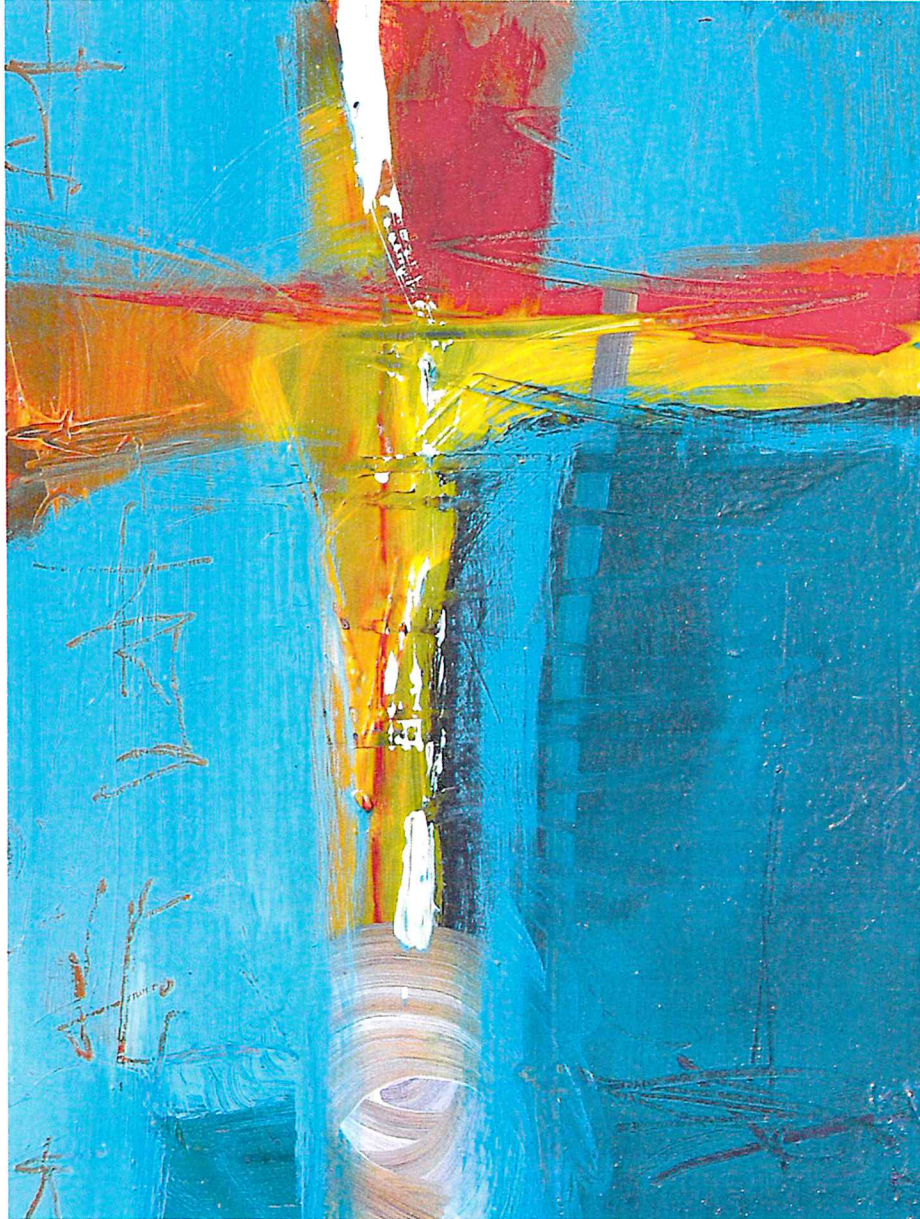

Service of Tenebrae

Tenebrae is the Latin word for darkness; the ancient service of Tenebrae dates from the Eighth Century. With each segment of the story, a candle will be extinguished until the sanctuary is completely dark, commemorating the darkness that fell over the land as Christ was crucified.
